Clinical Innovations:

Co-founder of The Landing at McLean Hospital (2010)	I co-built this short-term (six weeks) residential program to fill a clinical needs gap by offering treatment to adolescents struggling with substance use disorders and co-occurring mental health disorders (e.g., anxiety, depression, mood disorders). Along with the Program Director (Jessica Feinberg), with mentoring by Dr. Cynthia Kaplan, and support from clinical staff on the unit (including Kathryn Boger, PhD), I developed and implemented the business and clinical models for the program.
Co-founded the McLean Anxiety Mastery Program (MAMP) (2013)	MAMP is an innovative outpatient treatment program for pediatric anxiety disorders and OCD. MAMP is regarded as a national model for providing intensive, evidence-based care for this patient population and draws patients from around the world. Our team has disseminated information about this model through journal articles, webinars, on-site trainings, and local, regional, and national talks. In addition, we have hosted conference calls and site-visits with regional colleagues who are looking to learn from and replicate our model.
Founded the McLean School Consultation Service (SCS) (2017)	The SCS is a unique consultation service with the mission to empower school districts to support the mental health needs of their students. The SCS began in 2017 with three school districts, expanded to nine school districts in year two, and in the 2020-2021 academic year is contracted with twelve school districts, one charter school, and one private school for a total of 57 schools (of note: all schools reached out to us asking for consultation through word-of-mouth recommendations or first-hand experience seeing our team in action at talks or with other districts). I have led our team in innovating through curriculum development and delivery (including a

Report of Teaching and Education Innovations

Co-created a shared video conferencing lecture series for fellows at three unaffiliated Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Residency Training Programs (2017)	The default mode of providing didactic seminars for residents is for each training program to create their own courses, exclusively using faculty from their own institution, though not all child psychiatry departments across the country have enough concentrated expertise in every teaching area. I joined with faculty from NYU Langone Child Study Center, University of Vermont Medical Center, and MedStar Georgetown University Hospital and contributed to a shared 10-session seminar entitled “Positive Child Psychiatry and Wellness.” Each one-hour session was broadcasted live to trainees in the three programs via videoconference in the fall semester. A pre and post-course test was administered to assess the degree to which content was retained and influential. Based on feedback, this seminar was highly successful in delivering innovative content in a format that was able to draw upon the shared resources of multiple programs. Podcast recordings of our training sessions were recorded for asynchronous delivery of content to accommodate different didactic schedules for unaffiliated programs. We have presented this innovative approach at AADPRT (American Association of Directors of Psychiatric Residency Training).

Directed implementation of telepsychiatry in the McLean Anxiety Mastery Program (MAMP) and McLean School Consultation Service (2017-2021)	This telepsychiatry implementation served as the sole pilot program for telepsychiatry at McLean Hospital, and our programs serve as a resource for colleagues looking to build this service in their clinics. As a result of this, I am part of the Outpatient Digital Health Workgroup under the umbrella of the Partners System Behavioral and Mental Health Initiative (mission: utilizing technology to expand access and enhance care for patients).
Co-directed implementation of a Virtual Reality Pilot in MAMP (2020-2021)	In collaboration with Daniel Gittins Stone, PhD (MAMP post-doc) and Katharyn Boger, PhD, ABPP, I helped design and am overseeing the implementation of Virtual Reality for Exposure Therapy with adolescents participating in the MAMP program. Due to COVID-19 related restrictions, this pilot was redesigned to be conducted fully virtually and has served as an additional engagement and treatment tool for adolescents struggling with anxiety disorders and OCD. In addition, I am consulting with several leaders from other McLean programs as they consider VR pilots for their patients.
